Examination Expectations



- Refer to the CSC Assessment Policy available on the College website.
- Students with AARA's must confirm arrangements with the Senior School Deputy Principal 24 hours prior to exam for alternative venues.
- It is the responsibility of all students to ensure that they are in attendance at the correct time, on the correct date, at the correct room for assessments which involve them.
- Late students will not be admitted to a written examination. They must report to the office.
- Students who are absent for a timetabled session must ask a parent or guardian to contact a member of the College's Administration on the day of the examination to explain their absence. Explained absences must be supported by a doctor's certificate.
- Students are not permitted to leave assessment sessions early. Students will remain in attendance for the full session or until the supervisor releases the entire group.
- Mobile phones/electronic devices and smart watches are not permitted in exam venues.
- Students are not permitted to talk with each other after they have entered the assessment room.
- DRESS: Students are to wear FULL SCHOOL FORMAL UNIFORM.
