Examination Expectations

- Refer to the CSC Assessment Policy available on the College website.
- Students with AARA's must confirm arrangements with the Senior School Deputy Principal 24 hours prior to exam for alternative venues.
- It is the responsibility of all students to ensure that they are in attendance at the correct time, on the correct date, at the correct room for assessments which involve them.
- Late students will be admitted at the supervisors discretion.
- Students are not permitted to leave assessment sessions early. Students will remain in attendance for the full session or until the supervisor releases the entire group.
- Students must bring their Student ID and equipment in a clear plastic bag.
- Mobile phones/electronic devices and smart watches are not permitted in exam room.
- Students must bring their own clear bottle of water.
- Students are not permitted to talk with each other once they have entered the exam room.
- Students must sit in alphabetical order at their allocated desk.
- DRESS: Students are to wear FULL SCHOOL FORMAL UNIFORM.
- Students must follow the school wide expectations at all times: I Am Safe, I Am Respectful, I Am Responsible.
- Unable to attend due to illness –
 - A student who is ill and unable to attend the external assessment should inform Ms Perren/ Assessment Supervisor of their illness as soon as practicable through the main office. This may be before, during or immediately after the external assessment session.
 - Supporting documentation **will be** required from an independent health professional to explain the specific aspects of the illness as per the QCAA guidelines. This process needs to be discussed with Ms Perren.
