



## COORPAROO SECONDARY COLLEGE COLLEGE SPORTING ACTIVITIES

Coorparoo Secondary College have built an excellent reputation for our sporting success. We are proud of the fact that students do not have to be an athlete to be a team member. All that we ask is that they try their best.

Parents/Guardians are required to complete the attached medical form which covers summer and winter interschool sport, recreational sport and all college carnivals. This form needs to be completed at the time of enrolment. If any information changes parents/guardians are required to inform the college of this.

### **WEDNESDAY INTERSCHOOL & RECREATIONAL SPORT**

CSC offer Interschool Sport during Period 4 each Wednesday afternoon. In the first two weeks of the school year students will be asked to select their preferences for the summer. A second selection process will be undertaken for the winter season which commences mid-May. Students will be notified of the choices during the first Wednesday of sport selections. Due to the large number of schools within the South District and the varying sizes of schools there is a two tier competition where we compete against similar size schools on Wednesday only, however our students still have the opportunity to qualify for Met Finals.

Summer Interschool fixtures run from February to April and are held at a variety of venues. Winter Interschool fixtures run from May to August. Parents/guardians should be aware that students competing at outside venues may occasionally not return to school until 3.00 – 3.20pm.

The college heavily subsidises Interschool Sport, however there is a levy of \$45 per season (winter & summer) for participation which covers venue hire, transport and umpiring fees.

#### **Important Points**

- Sport is compulsory. Please do not book appointments for your child during this time period.
- Students driving or being driven to an outside venue need to provide a note from their parents/guardians giving such permission.
- Interschool team members are expected to travel by bus.

### **COORPAROO SECONDARY COLLEGE CARNIVALS**

#### **College Swimming Carnival**

CSC interhouse swimming carnival will be a whole school event with every student attending and cheering on their house. This event is held early in the school year at Musgrave Park Pool Complex. Students will be transported by bus to and from Musgrave Park Pool. School starts at the normal time with roll marking in the hall.

#### **College Cross Country Carnival**

CSC interhouse cross country will be held at the end of Term 1 with every student expected to participate. The carnival is held in and around the College grounds. This is a half day event and will begin at approximately 12.30pm with roll marking in the hall.

#### **College Athletics Carnival**

CSC interhouse athletics carnival will be a whole college event with every student expected to attend and participate by competing or cheering on their house. This will be held mid-year either at the end of term 2 or beginning of term 3 at Coorparoo Secondary College. School starts at the normal time with roll marking in the hall.

## **SOUTH DISTRICT 13-19 YEARS SPORT CARNIVALS**

### **South District Swimming Trials**

The district swimming trials will be held at Chandler Aquatic Centre. This event will be through nomination only due to the early scheduling in the school year. If your student wishes to nominate and compete they are to see the Sports Coordinator in the staff house where they will provide the required permission forms. There may be a fee (amount TBC) for these trials to cover the cost of venue hire. Students will also be responsible to arrange their own transport to and from the venue.

### **South District Cross Country Trials**

The district cross country will be held at Citipointe Christian College in late April. This is a full day event and students who qualify to represent the college at these trials will be transported to and from the venue by bus. Students will be required to return the appropriate forms before they are eligible to attend.

### **South District Athletics Trials**

The district athletics trials will be held over 2 days at the Qld Sport & Athletics Centre at Macgregor in early August. Students qualifying to attend these trials will need to return the permission form and possibly pay a levy before they are able to attend. Students will be transported to and from the venue each day by bus and the levy will help cover some of the cost of transport and venue hire.

## **LYTTON DISTRICT 10-12 YEARS SPORT CARNIVALS**

### **Lytton District Swimming Trials**

The district swimming trials will be held at Moreton Bay College. This event will be through nomination only due to the early scheduling in the school year. If your student wishes to nominate and compete they are to see the Sports Coordinator in the staff house where they will provide the required permission forms. There may be a fee (amount TBC) for these trials to cover the cost of venue hire. Students will also be responsible to arrange their own transport to and from the venue.

### **Lytton District Cross Country Trials**

The district cross country will be held at Villanova Park Fields, Tingalpa in late April. This is a half day event and students who qualify to represent the college at these trials will be transported to and from the venue by bus or taxi. Students will be required to return the appropriate forms before they are eligible to attend.

### **South District Athletics Trials**

The district athletics trials will be held over 2 days at the Villanova Park Fields, Tingalpa in early August. Students qualifying to attend these trials will need to return the permission form and possibly pay a levy before they are able to attend. Students will be transported to and from the venue each day by bus or taxi and the levy will help cover some of the cost of transport and nomination fee.

## **DISTRICT AND REGIONAL TEAM TRIALS 2015**

Lytton 10-12 years and South 13-19 years District Trial information will be put into the student notices, on the sports notice board and added to the college website or newsletter. Students will be required to collect all relevant paper work from the Sports Coordinator and make their own way to and from these trials, which are usually held outside of school time. Some district trials may incur a fee to trial, however most will not. Students who are successful in gaining selection into the South District team will receive paperwork to attend the Metropolitan East Trials. This paper work needs to be completed by parents/guardians and signed off by the college principal for students to attend. There will be a \$20 levy to trial for any Met East sport and students will again be responsible for arranging their own transport.
