- 6 new staff this year plus staff on leave. Some inconsistencies with policies & procedures. Uniform procedure & infringement policy discussed with Kate Jackson & Amanda Corn and "fine tuned". No detention if note from home. Jumpers are available for the day, to "trade". Currently, detention if no note for first & second offences, then afternoon detention for third infringement. It is detrimental to the school if students are not wearing correct uniform to & from school- so all staff to enforce this policy. Teachers to document "repeat offenders". Some changes to wording; footwear now "impervious uppers". Hair colour rules are not in school diary, since this is an abbreviated version of the policy, so this needs adding.
- Need to have an internal process (IP) for all policies. Uniform policy was reviewed today, so letter to be sent home to parents.
- Positive reinforcement- rewards for those students who follow the uniform policy. Applied for funds/vouchers for intrinsic awards e.g. tuckshop, mobile card etc
- Diary needs to be reviewed- approached at deputies conference- many students are provided with an electronic copy of their diary- CSC could consider this.
- Denim- not allowed, but not explicit in diary. Also (GK) no weekends in diary, yet many events occur at weekends. Carried over.
- Attached copy uniform policy and uniform infringement procedure.
